Schools Join Forces to Fight Closure !

For the first time in the TVDSB schools threatened with closure are joining forces, not JUST to defend their schools:

on Tuesday November 26th we will ALL be protesting at the TVDSB Board Office to demand better education and better use of taxpayer money.

Since the TVDSB Senior Administration started closing schools en-mass in 2006, the TVDSB's EQAO Scores have fallen well below the provincial average, yet their budget has climbed a whopping 30% to well over \$820mil this year alone. It has become abundantly clear that closing schools not only costs taxpayers more, it provides inferior education to our children. It's time for Trustees to take a stand. "Protect our schools, protect our children."

The failure of the Senior Administration to recognize the value and success of rural schools is appalling. Rural students have unique needs that aren't met by large, distant facilities. Our schools don't run at a deficit, but if the Senior Administration has their way, the education of our children will. Fair is not that everyone gets the same, fair is that everyone gets what they need. It's time to educate, not consolidate!
